I'm not complaining mind you....because the consistency of "Hot Wax" is what provides us the assurance that every time we walk out the door and head to a show that we are going to see a guaranteed quality show every time we see "Hot Wax" perform!

Now, my problem is that when our boys are this good every show and your as wordy as Ole "Ambassador Bob " is....then no matter how many great descriptive adjectives there are in the dictionary.....I have probably used them all up by now. Since Ole "A-Bob" doesn't like to repeat himself....since Ole "A-Bob" doesn't like to repeat himself....then I just have simply run out of ways to tell the world how great that "Hot Wax" is! Actually, with the huge record setting crowds that we have been drawing this season...is there anyone left out there who doesn't know first hand how terrific "Hot Wax" has been this season? If you are involved with "Hot Wax" like we all our....then don't you smile just a little and feel some extra pride when they announce on the radio that Saturday night we will be featuring the Great Show band....Hot Wax! Go ahead..admit it ...you know you do....I know I do!

I swear...I'm not fibbing....but at 1:05 am. Wednesday morning....the Song "Cara Mia" is currently being played and right before it started ...I immediately and instinctively flinched in anticipation of Rickmeister screaming from somewhere! The Rickmeister is responsible for at least 40 % of my new gray hair!

Ok....now let's get back to this awesome past weekend! There was something just extra special that happened Saturday night....and you never know what it isor why it is but you just feel it. You can ask anyone who was at Jim & Jacks this past Saturday.....and everyone will tell you the same thing! There was just special carma or something! The Jimster and I headed up to our home away from home, Jim & Jacks, a couple of hours early so we could get a chance to talk to both Jim's and Karen and of course our very favorite Hostess, Margie! We also went up to check on our 31 reservations.....and like usual Jim, Karen,Terry, Margje and the gang had us taken care of. My friends know that I am trying my best to get as many people as I can with who they want to be with...and that usually takes priority over the location of the seats...because everyone is going to wind up with good seats!

Anyway ...as I was waiting for people I was wondering what kind of evening it was going to be....and I thought that I had all of the answers because this was going to be one of the most predictable shows of the year...or so I thought! We must be nearing 20 shows or moreand we have performed at Jim & Jacks by far more than anywhere else. Now after 20 shows with no personal changes in the last several shows...and performing at our most familiar venue.....we should not be surprised by anything and pretty much know what to expect....right? We couldn't have been more wrong!

I had said last week in my commentary that I felt a party atmosphere coming on....and wow....did we party! I must have been psychic and no....I did not say psycho....because the entire place just had a party feel....and that went from the J&J people like Margie who had her usual fun at my expense...and I loved every minute of it....to the band itself and of course you "waxers". Although, our very hard working SOS boys were exhausted again as they just arrived in time from another show to do the "Hot Wax" show....they were in the spirit also!

We had at least 3 birthdays to celebrate and so many cakes...I lost count....but I'll talk more about that on the fan's page. Again...I can't explain what was going on Saturday night ...but you could see it in everyone face....as every smile from one "waxer" was met with a smile from another....and even people I didn't know greeted me with smiles. I looked around the room....and Lucy was ready to party...you could just see it...of course Lucy is always ready to party.....scratch that ...poor example...LoL! Debb was ready, Pat Roth was ready, Mary was ready, Denny was ready, Nancy was ready...heck.... we were all ready!

Now, a little about this great show. The show opened with it's traditional "Rock this Town" number....and TGS has now officially put his name and claim to that song as it has officially become Sigsbee's. It just sounds like he should be singing it....and he is! Then TGS blasted into those very familiar chords that you only hear in a Buddy Holly song! TGS brought the crowd to their feet and received I'm sure his first of many future standing ovations. I do know that the 22 year old young lady ,Rebecca, who came to the last show and did the hula hoop so well last week....loved every minute of the show and is currently trying to think of every way possible to get off work this weekend so she can come "Bash"!

All 3 of my youngsters who are coming to the Summer bash are all very fair and open minded peopleso I know they will not prejudge the show before they see it.....and if they come with an open mind like I know they will than they will have a great time! You just can't help from having a great time....it's simply not possible and most of these youngster tend to return ...and bring friends with them. Then they are hooked and then just like the caterpillar that morphs into a beautiful butterfly....the normal first timer....then after 3 shows or so slowly morphs into a wonderful "waxer"....and it is a beautiful thing to see! Holy moly....geez....I'm starting to scare myself now! I may need a slight break after this show to go sit on a real beach somewhere for a little while! Al....Ole "A-Bob" is going to put you in a safe environment at a table with other youngsters of your own age....because us older 'waxers" are an enthusiastic bunch and we don't want to scare you off....so you may sit back and observe all of our rituals ...or feel free to join in....LOL! At some point....when we feel it is safe we will slowly incorporate you youngsters into the main population with us wild "waxers!" Ok...time to move on....I think I milked every ounce out of this!

Besides TGS new Buddy Holly medley.....we saw something else new at the last show at Jim & Jacks! Well you know what....the more I think about it....I am not going to say...because it was something new by Einstein....and I want the people Saturday night to have the same reaction this week as we had last week when we first saw this new addition to the act. I do know one thing and that was that Einstein had a brilliant night on stage and probably his best since he joined "Hot Wax" in my humble opinion. His comedic skills get better each week as I think that Einstein gets more and more comfortable with the fact that he is with a rock band.....and that the fans have accepted him in a rock n' roll band and truly love him now.

Einstein has truly become a fan favorite....and I would be fibbing if I said that we were all sure that was going to happen after we saw him at his first show. I think that shows that Buddy will not let his ego get in the way...if there is a chance to get the sound better.....and that the show comes first! Now guys.....one more suggestion...could I hear a little more of Buddy Holly's guitar on that medley....yeah I knowwe don't want to drown out Sigsbee. Ok that was fun for a few minutes....but now we better let the real experts take over....LoL!! Thanks SOS boys, Buddy, Rocky & Tiny for the extra outstanding job you guys have done this season....just seems like you guys work all the time anymore!

Anyway...I started to talk about how multi talented Charlie was....and like I said....not only is Charlie good on the keys....but can play the banjo also...and I'm guessing some guitar also. Charlie is now wailing away and showing off his harmonica skills also on the "I'm so Glad I'm living in the USA " number. All of this versatility is important in a band ...because down the road it may allow "Hot Wax" to learn some numbers that they might not have been able to attempt without this versatility. Again....like most successful men...there is always a good woman behind him....and Bonita would certainly fit that description.....and again we are thrilled and delighted to have them both with us.

I wanted to talk about our boy Boomerour very POPULAR and, yep I meant that to be in capital letters, talented and fun loving bass player. I don't have enough time here to do Boomer justice in this commentary....but when I was talking about the party feel at the show....I think that Boomer sublimely sets the tone for the crowd and the band! When you are sitting back in the audience and you are looking on stage....and the Boomer is movin and groovin with all of the moves and the facial gestures...it just seems to fire us all up! Boomer's energy makes us think that the performers are not just there because they have to be or that it is just a pay day or a job. Boomer gives the impression that he wants to be there and that he is having fun! When we fans feel that a guy or a band is not giving great effort and is just going through the motions or maybe lack of motions in this case...then we kind of have that same lack of desire or effort in the crowd....and we don't feel like rewarding an effort like that. We sometimes feel that it takes effort to clap or cheer or stand up ...so why should I give any more effort....than I'm getting.....especially since I am not even getting paid and he is However Boomer makes it look like every band member is hustling and working hard and in "Hot Wax" they actually are.... which in turn fires all of us up.....and now were ready to have fun! Now ...the tone is set for a rousing good time.....and like I said...I think Boomer sets a lot of the tone for our party atmosphere! We don't need to say too much about Boomer's lovely wife....because I think Angie already knows how we feel about he...she's a sweetie.....and just so much fun to be around and Angie is really enjoying the ride!

I must say this....though....no matter what the circumstances are or have been at a show....whether it was illness, bad, new, or small crowd...or simply bad weather...."Hot Wax" absolutely has never shown up and not given their best effort. That doesn't mean that there are never any mistakes...because although our boys come close....no band is perfect all of the time.....but "Hot Wax" will never cheat you on their effort. A lack of effort just has never been tolerated in the past with this proud band with their long rich history dating back to 1984.....and it will never be tolerated in the future as long as Bobby is involved!

JIM & JACKS SHOW - FAN'S PAGE - (08 -19 - 06) : OK....all of you "waxers" should be ashamed at yourselves for your behavior Saturday night at Jim & Jacks. I have 3 youngsters coming to the show this week like I mentioned in my commentary and they are in their early 30's....and Ole "A-Bob" is excited to see them as it has been more than a couple of years...probably 6 or 7 maybe. Don't you guys let me down and cancel on me. I already have talked about you too much. Seriously Al, Heather and Ted...can't wait to see you....hope we still recognize each other....although I only saw Heather a few times ...I think....bring the Stuman!

I have never seen the excitement that is surrounding the "Bash". "Waxers" are just in a frenzy! The closest I can come to this feeling was when the boys opened their first show with all new songs and band mates! This will be one of the most memorable shows in HW history in my humble opinion! counting! We have a challenge to beat....so keep looking for potential "Hot Waxers"! Greg , the owner of the Palace, said that the last "Hot Wax" crowd drew 251 people....which was a record at that time. The new record to beat is 291....that would be tough in the middle of Summer....but if every "waxer" put just a few moments thought into bringing just one person extra....then we would shatter the record!
